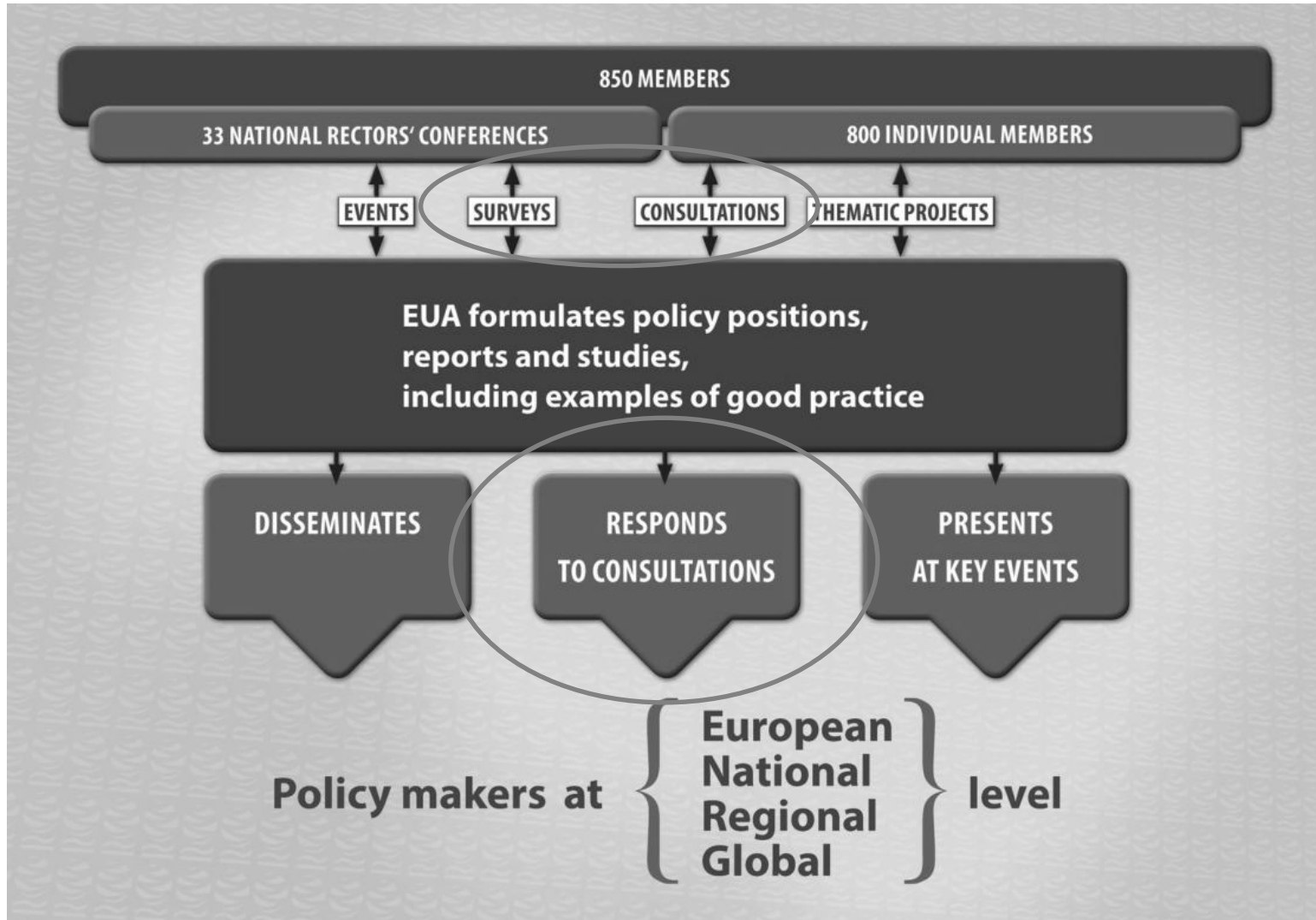

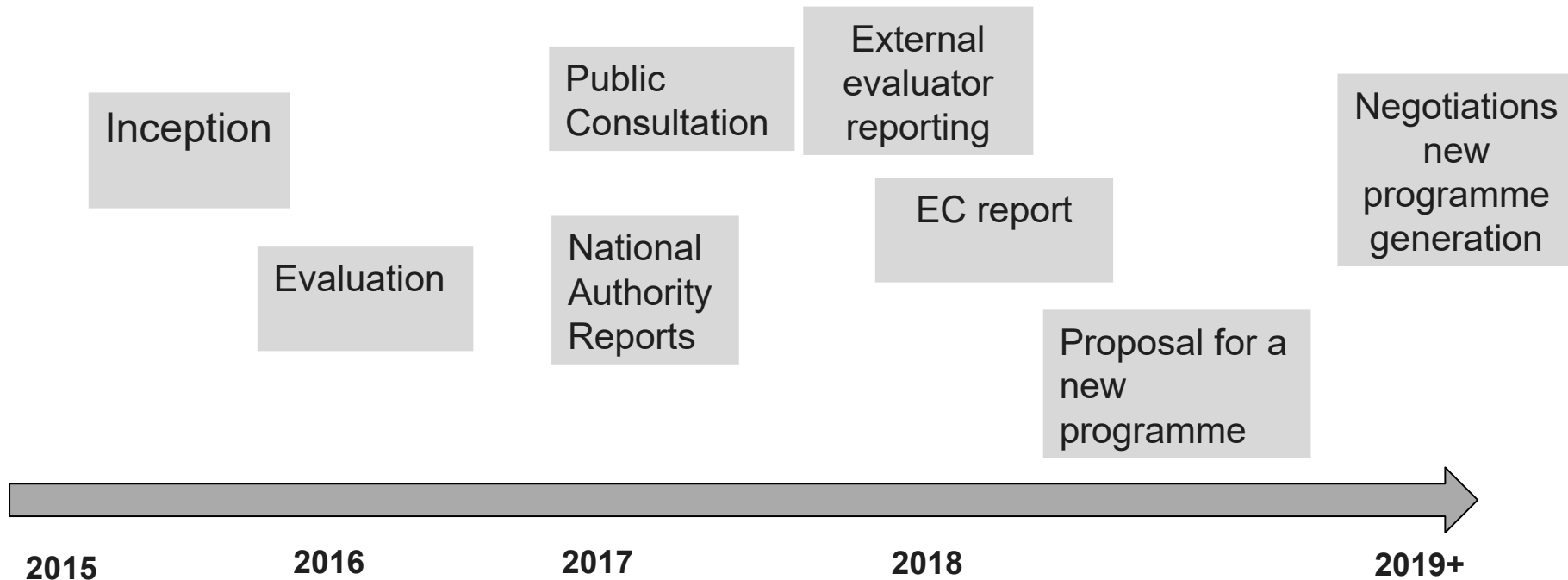

- Impact previous programme generations



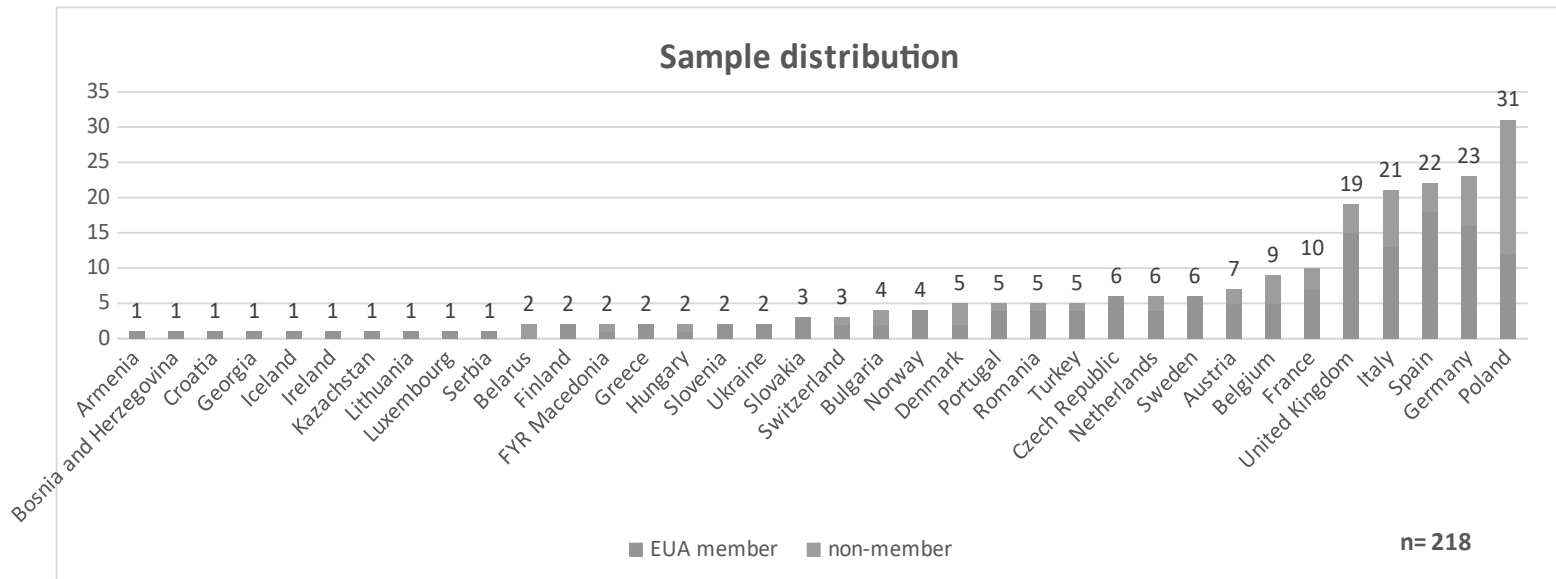

- Countries – size of institutions



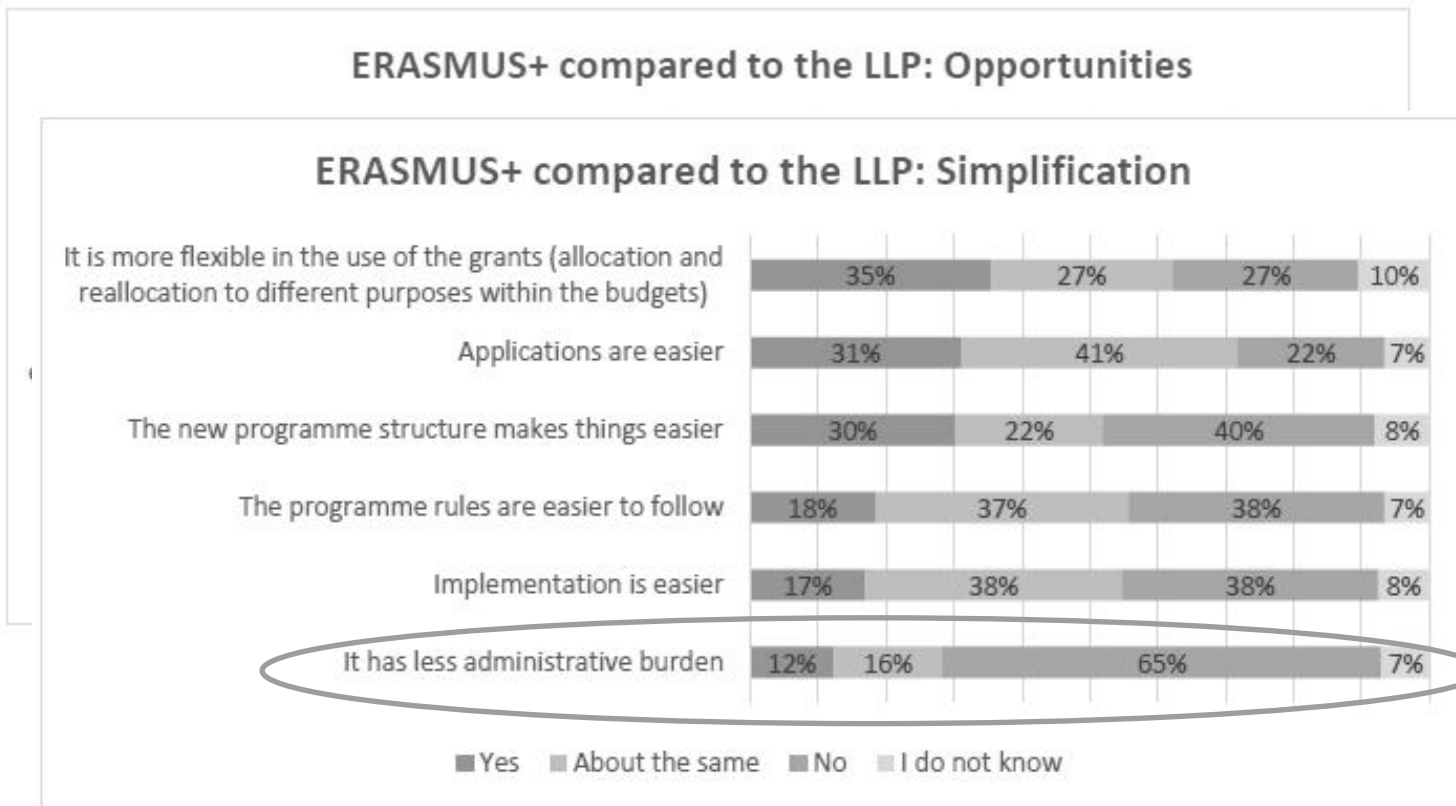


Erasmus+ Midterm Review: EUA activities

 - ✓ EUA's Membership Consultation survey
- October 2016 EUA Council
 - ✓ Draft conclusion from the membership consultation
- November 2016
 - ✓ Membership consultation report – publication of key findings
- December 2016 – draft recommendations
 - ✓ Based on the report
 - ✓ Sent to NRC & partner organisations for comments
- February 2017
 - ✓ Final recommendations publication

(A) Simplification



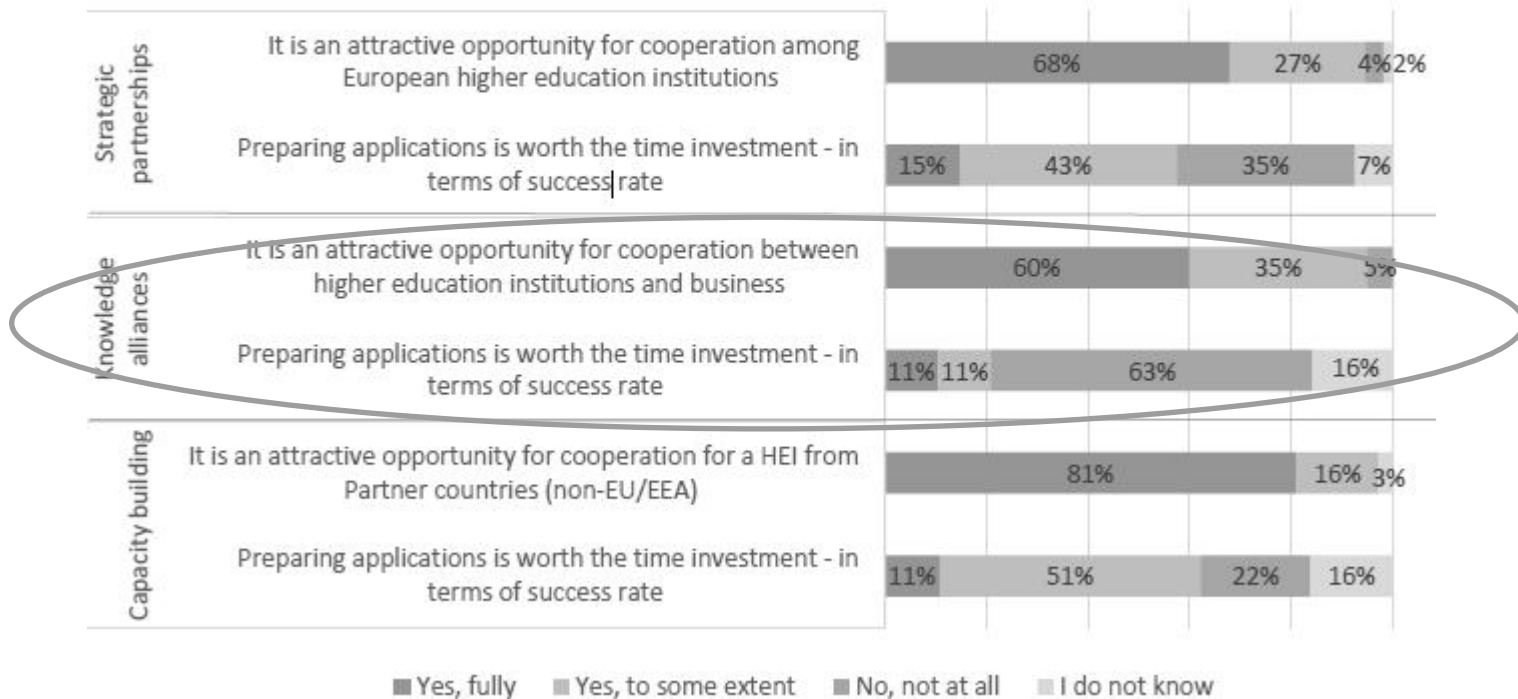
- I. Continue to simplify rules, requirements and processes for application, management and reporting, in order to decrease the administrative burden.

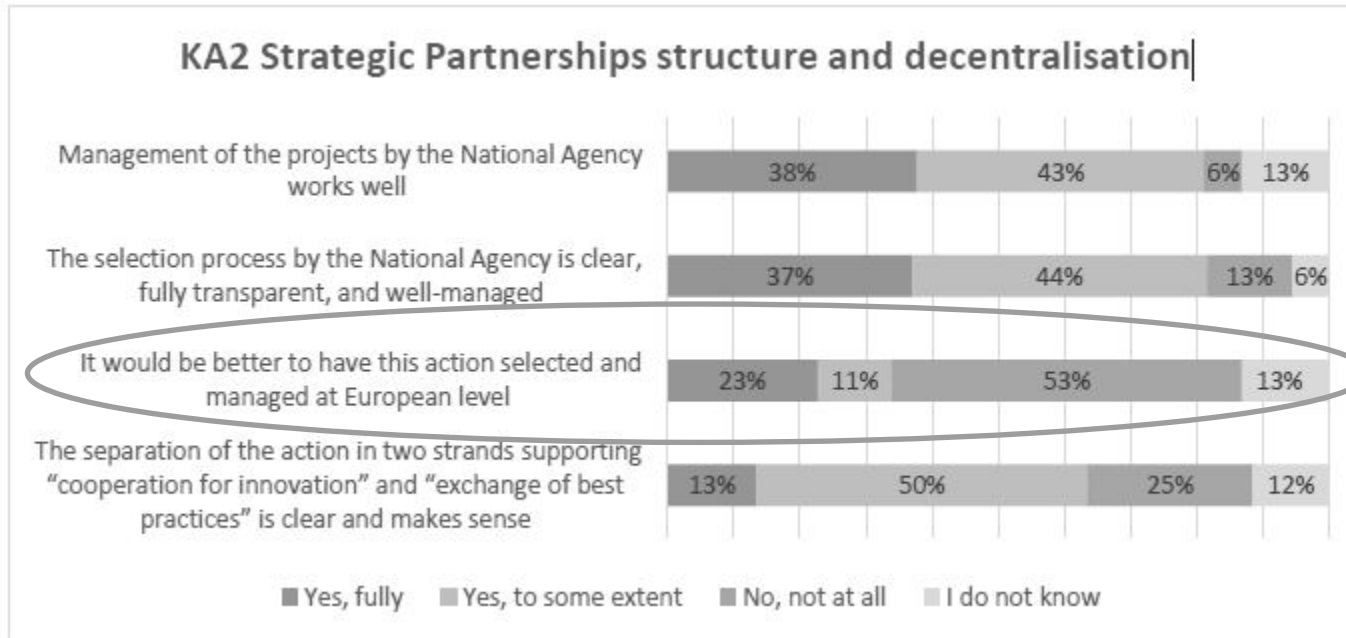
III. Improve funding and funding efficiency

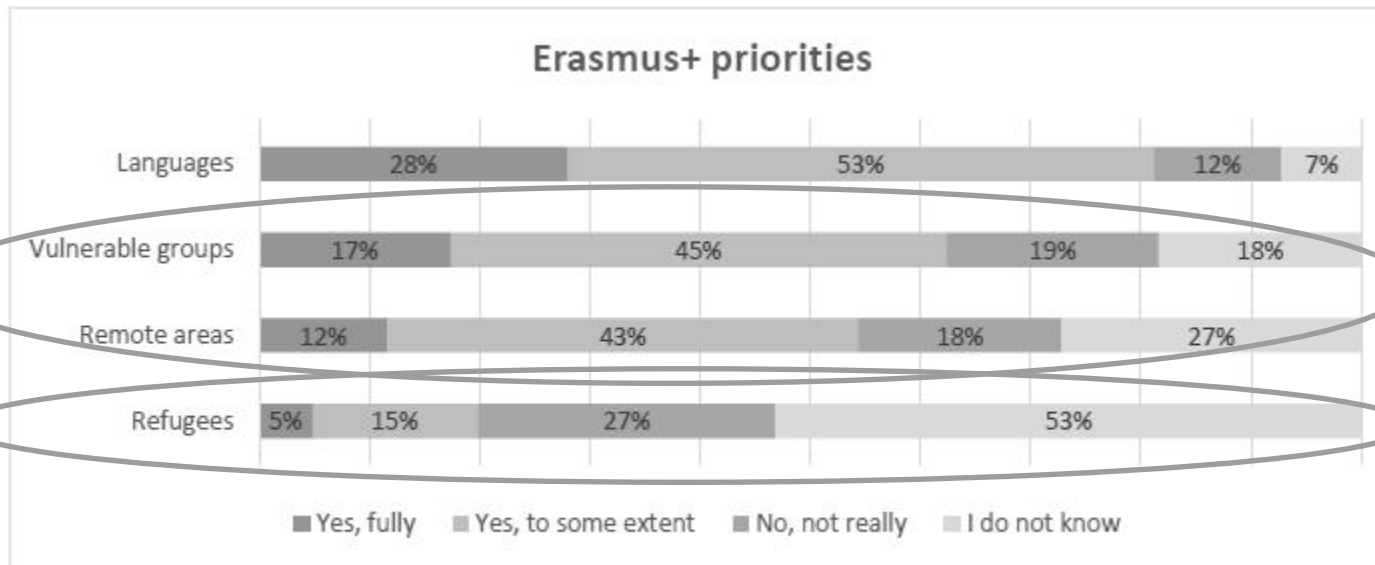


Figure 9: Do you think the Erasmus+ Programme succeeds in addressing the priorities it has set for itself regarding the following areas? (Q14)
