The Programme

The programme contributes to train highly qualified professionals and managerial staff for sustainable development in the partner countries. The programme thus offers scholarships mainly to future university teachers from developing countries for postgraduate courses and for doctorates. They study at universities in their home country or at highly qualified institutions in the region, some of which are organised in networks.



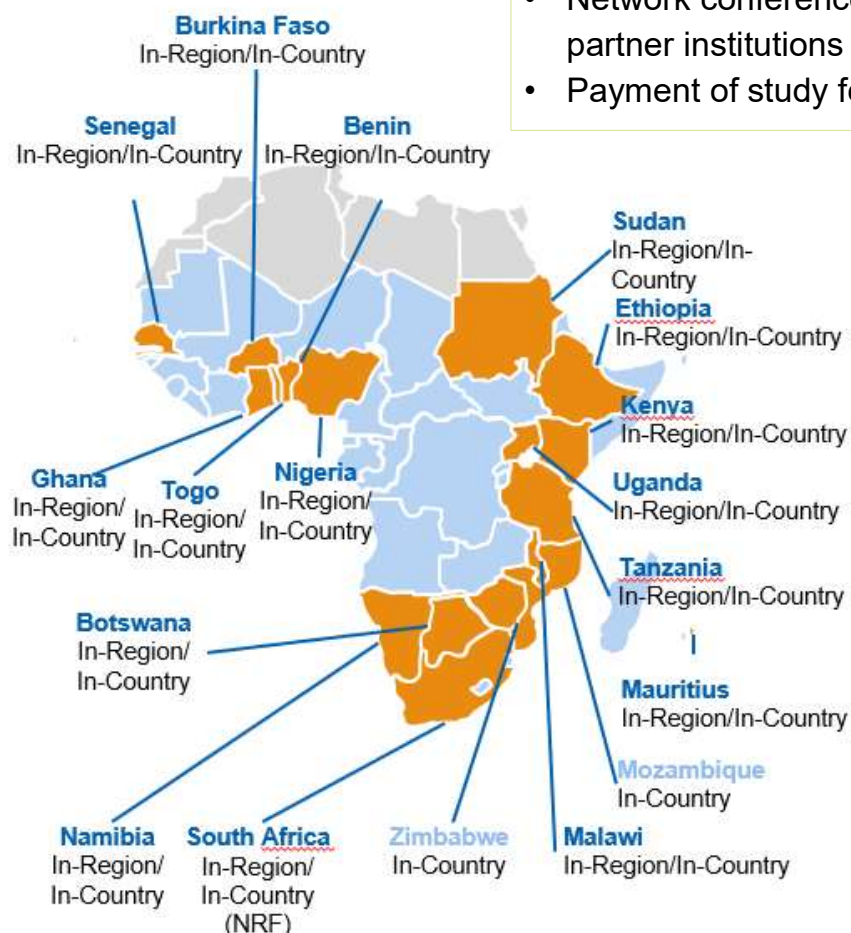
Activities

- Scholarships (MA, PhD) for development-related (post)graduate programmes (including research allowances)
- Short-term research-stays in Germany
- Summer Schools in Germany
- Support for Alumni
- Network conferences for partner institutions
- Payment of study fees

Programme Outcomes

- Graduates are qualified to take on responsible positions in or for their region of origin: **In 2018, 1800 scholarship holders were supported; 80% recognize an improvement for their professional/academic development**
- The participation of women and underprivileged groups is reinforced: **In 2018, 48% female scholarship holders, 35% coming from LDC-countries**
- Organizational, financial and personal capacities of partner institutions are strengthened: **80% of the partner institutions indicate that their capacities are strengthened**
