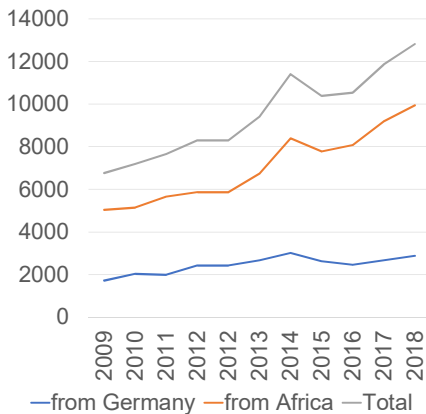


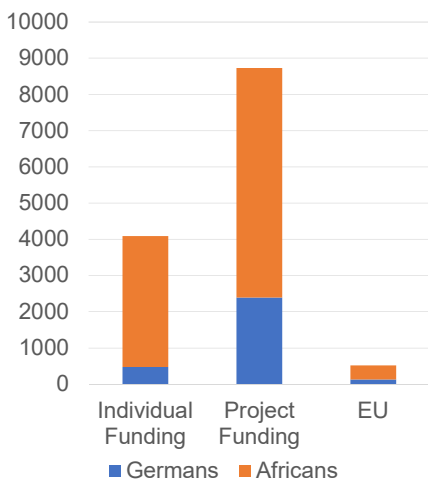

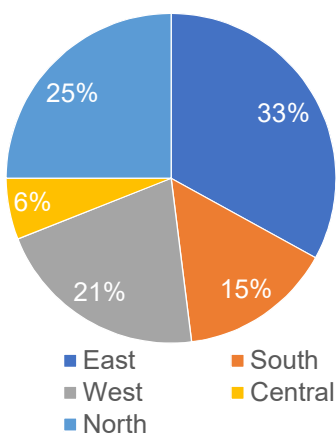
Funding People 2009-2018

Highlights

In Country/In-Region Programme

The In-Country/In-Region programme supports the training of future professionals, managerial staff and university teachers. It offers the African scholarship holders the opportunity to pursue postgraduate or doctoral studies at universities in their home country or at highly qualified institutions on the continent.

Building capacities

In the framework of the three programme-lines “Centres of African Excellence”, “Bilateral SDG Graduate Schools” and the “African Institute for Mathematical Sciences (AIMS)”, DAAD is supporting university centres of international standing at 18 different locations across the continent.

Government Scholarship Programmes

The DAAD cooperates with the governments in Kenya, Ghana, Nigeria, Ethiopia, Rwanda, Tunisia and Egypt in the context of co-funded governmental scholarships to Germany.

DAAD offers a bundle of measures – training courses, dialogue events, projects and partnerships - that foster professionalisation of institutional management processes, alignment of education to international quality standards and strengthening of research capacities.

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
