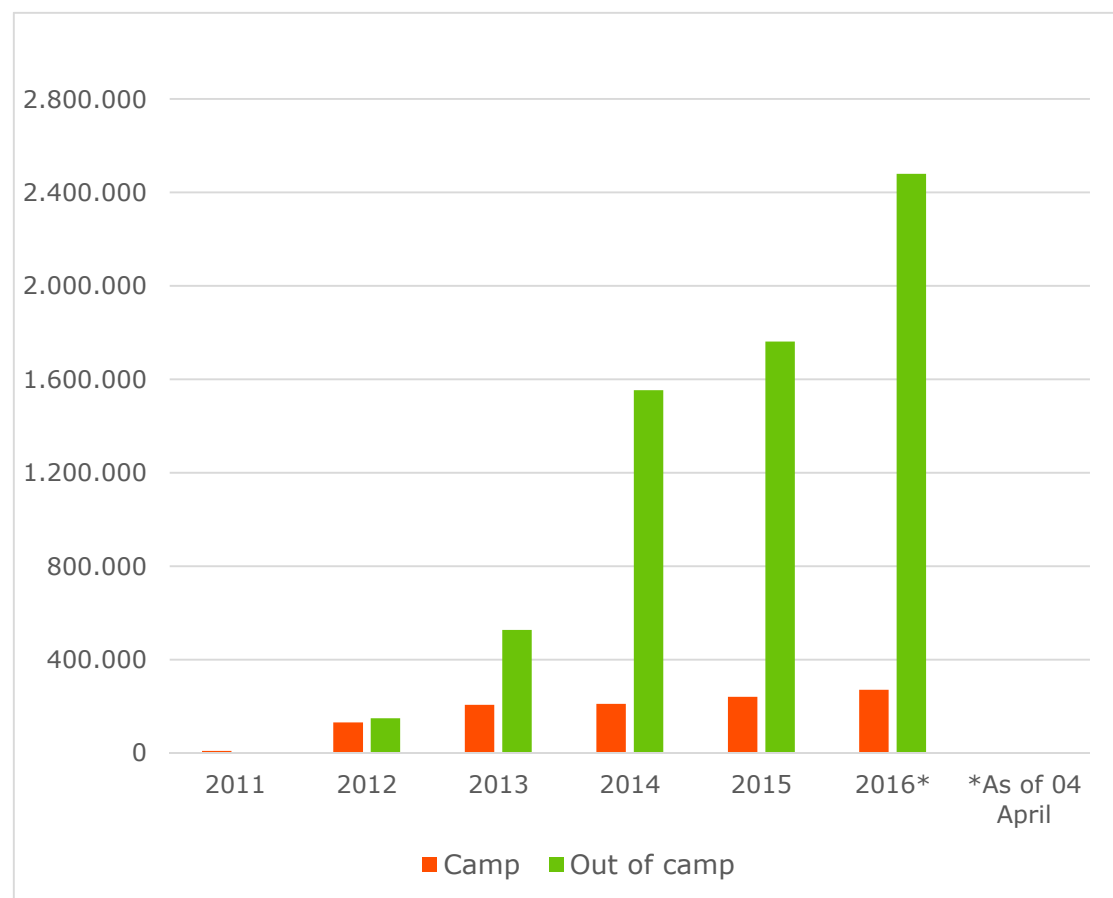

Syrian Refugees in Turkey



- **2.7 million** registered persons
- **10% in camps** (26 camps in 10 provinces along SE border)
- **90% outside camps**

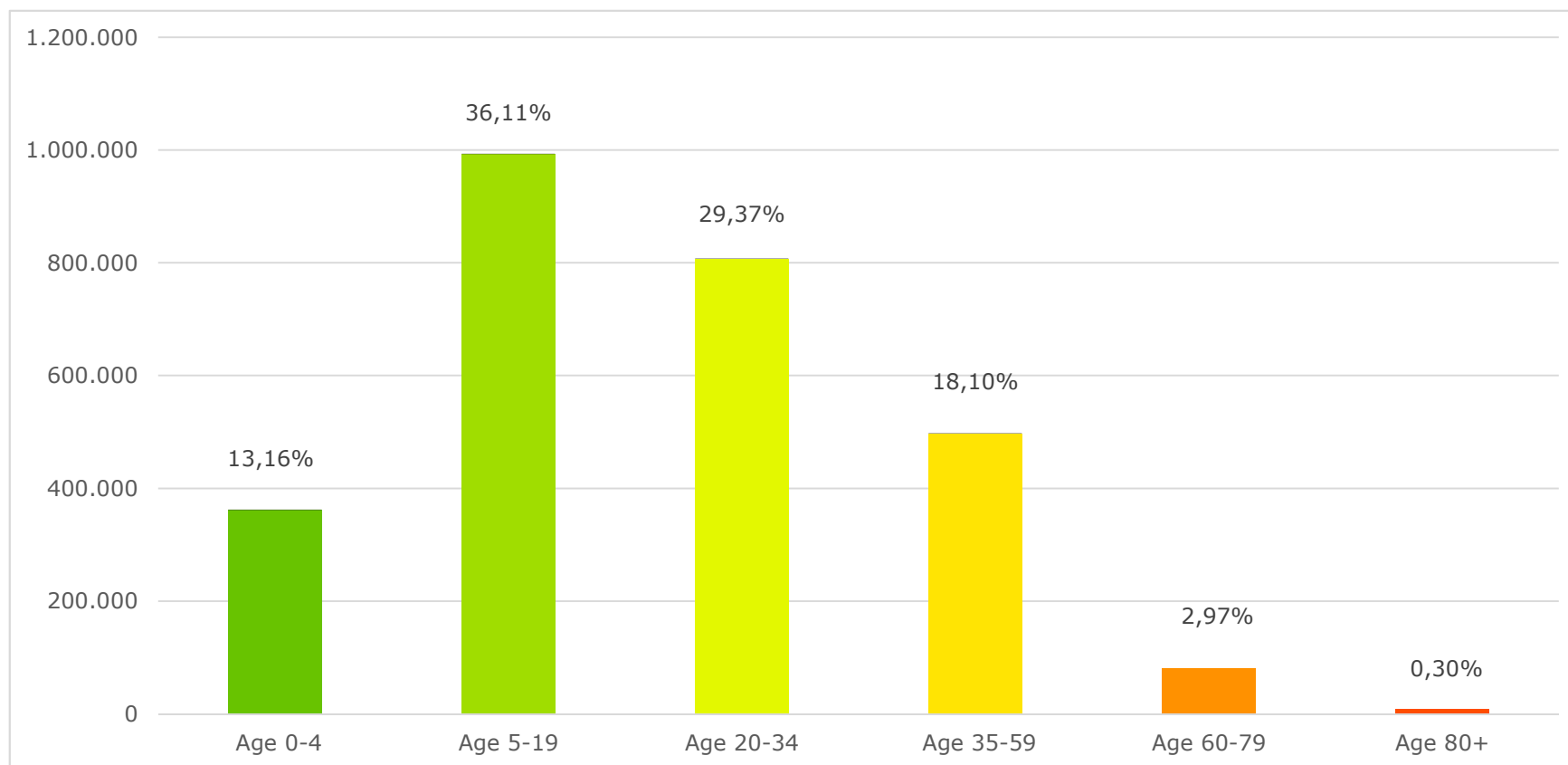

Education

Key Figures

- **Half a million** children (5-17 years) are out-of-school
- Enrolment in school: **90%** in camps; **26%** outside camps
- Enrolment rates by education stage:

Pre-school (3-5 yrs)	7%
Primary school (5-14 yrs)	40%
Secondary school (14-17 yrs)	14%

- **77%** in Temporary Education Centers & **23%** in Turkish Public Schools

Education

Priority Needs

- Increased enrolment in all stages of education
 - Incentives
 - Remedial education
 - Accelerated language
 - Capacity (schools, teachers)
 - Transportation
 - Scholarships
- Increased community-based initiatives (pre-school)
- Access to school for SEN children
