
The MEnS is an association that implements, by coordinating its members and partners, actions to promote the academic integration of all people in exile within higher education institutions.





FORMATIONS "PASSERELLE" / THE BRIDGING COURSES

These courses are created specifically for exiled students and provided by 38 higher education institutions in France.

The training courses include :

- French language classes
- Cultural and intercultural activities
- Socio-professional support
- Individual help in order to resume studies in France




The University Diploma (DU) Passerelle


