





## **Facts & Figures I**

- Established in 2016
- > For Researchers at Severe and Acute Individual Risk
- PostDocs to Senior Professors
- > Higher Education Institutions as applicants and grantees
- > Fully-funded 24-months fellowships (stipend or employment at postdoc level)
- > Optional 12-months extension (co-financed with host institution)
- > Auxiliary funds for the host institution: 20,000 EUR per fellow hosted
  - > to provide individual training, coaching, language classes for PSI fellows
  - > to help establish long-term support structures at host institutions
- > Steady state pre-2022: 50 fellowships per year in 2 calls for nominations



# **General challenges: managing transitions**

- Returning to home country
- Transitioning from a rescue programme to regular funding programmes within German/Europe/internationally
- Providing orientation in a safe/ different research landscape
- Signposting employment opportunities outside science; alternative career options
- Providing coaching and advice for these transitions



# Specific challenges: 2021 ff

- Since August 2021: increased demand in response to crises
- Parallel crises: Belarus, Afghanistan, Ukraine, ...
- Special Initiatives to respond to individual crises:
  - 2022: PSI Bridge Fellowships Afghanistan: 20 one-year fellowships (partly extended until end of 2023)
  - 2022: PSI Emergency Fund Ukraine: 26 preparatory short-term fellowships
  - 2022: > doubled fellowship numbers, focus Ukraine: 61 full PSI fellowships
  - 2023: PSI Special Programme Iran: approx. 15-20 full PSI fellowships, selection ongoing
- Consequences for researchers at risk from other regions
- Appropriate ad-hoc response vs. sustainable dimensions and reliable support structures



### Alexander von **HUMBOLDT** STIFTUNG



- ➤ MSCA4Ukraine for displaced researchers from Ukraine
- Announced in May 2022 as part of the EU response to Russian Federation's invasion of Ukraine
- Enables doctoral and postdoctoral researchers to continue their work at academic and non-academic institutions
- Host institutions in EU and Horizon Europe associated members states
- ≻ Total programme budget: 25 million EUR

#### MSCA4Ukraine Fellowships (subject to change):


- > 124 fellowships granted to host organizations
- > 13 doctoral and 111 postdoctoral
- > 65% female, 35% male researchers
- Duration: 8 24 months

## **MSCA4Ukraine**

#### > 21 host countries

Applications submitted by host organisations in France, Belgium, the Netherlands, Germany, Czechia and Finland were on average more successful, compared to what would have been expected based on the number of applications submitted
